C.3 Excursion on reserve day

On Friday, July the 24th (reserve day), we intend to go on a whole-day excursion to the Island of Fur. We will visit the local Brewery of Fur. Lunch is served at the brewery and of course tasting of the different beers.

In addition to this we will have a guided tour through the "Moler" (mo-clay) open pits. See the following description written by the tour guide:

Walking in the Dawn of New Life

A special attraction of our Limfjord Area is a geological wonder, which holds both fossils and visual beauty. White diatomite and 55 million years old volcanic ash layers are gently folded during last ice age and neatly displayed in pits and coastal cliffs. The ancient earth layer was formed in early Eocene (a period in the Earth's history) – 'Eocene' is Greek meaning 'Dawn of New Ages'. Meaning the time when life on Earth picked up after the dinosaurs became extinct – so sorry no dinos. But our fossil record is that of life thriving during tropical conditions even high to the north allowing overwhelming expansion of life forms. The fossil hunt will take you to this fine site and the museum will show you 50 years of marvellous fossil trophies in our safe keeping. The fossil hunt is like a geological lottery, it's your luck that sets the odds. We can assure you a mini volcanic event that displays the cataclysmic birth of early Iceland 55 million years ago. Also the finding of a fossil turd (Coprolite) is almost certain, as well as the story behind the name.

The price is still EUR 160 and 180 per hour respectively for C150/152 and C172.

Since we do have some problems to obtain enough C150's for hire in Denmark, we are going to get some planes from our neighbor countries.

We will arrange the ferry flights to Skive and back. For these ferry flights we will charge a lump sum of <u>EUR 150 per. pilot</u> so that these ferry costs are shared equally among all pilots who rent aircraft.

C.6 License validation

For pilots holding a license issued by a non-EASA country, we need declaration from the respective countries authorities that the pilot license is in accordance with ICAO Annex I.

Danish CAA requires that above declaration to be made in the respective CAA official papers. The countries concerned are informed via mail.

C.7 Competition map

The map, used during the competition, will be a road map, scale 1:200.000, provided by the organizer. A copy of the competition map and forms for each participating pilot, will be posted to each team in week 26. The competition map is also available on the website for download.

C.8 Aircraft Insurance

In the local rules C.8.2 is by mistake written: Each competing aircraft must be insured against 3rd Party Public Liability claims with at least <u>EUR 8.000.000</u>.

The right numbers according EU regulation:

1.500.000 SDR (500-999 kg MTOW)

3.000.000 SDR (1000-2700 kg MTOW) (1 SDR is approximately 1,23 Euro)

C.9 Doping Control

Doping tests may be carried out in accordance with FAI drug rules and doping rules of Anti-doping Committee of Denmark.

C.10 Training week
