

## Validation of Pilot license

According to "Local Rules" C7.5:

 Declaration from the respective countries authorities that the pilot license is in accordance with ICAO Annex I. http://www.icao.int/safety/ism/ICAO%20Annexes/Annex%201.pdf

If the evidence is not sufficient, pilot training may be needed to fulfill the requirements as imposed in (EU) No 1178/2011 Annex III section. 5 to be flying in a Danish registered aircraft. <u>http://eur-</u>

- Pilots must document a radio license with a language level of English equivalent to a minimum of grade 4 according JAR-FCL 055
